

Motorsport UK British Kart Championships - Tyre Ordering.

Q: How do I order tyres?

A: Competitors that wish to order tyres for events will need to follow the link at <https://kartinguk.alphatiming.co.uk/register/series>:

Q: What if I have already ordered tyres?

A: Competitors that have already ordered tyres will have these carried over to their first event.

Q: What if I have had my ordered tyres refunded, and now want to re-enter?

A: Competitors that have had their tyres refunded will need to order tyres using the following link at <https://kartinguk.alphatiming.co.uk/register/series>:

Q: Can I order additional tyres?

A: Competitors that have already ordered tyres, can order additional tyres to their original order at <https://kartinguk.alphatiming.co.uk/register/series>. Please refresh yourselves with your class regulations to what tyres are allowed see appendix 1 below.

Q: Can I order practice tyres of the same batch?

A: Those classes where the regulations allow new practice tyres, you can order the same batch practice slicks and wets online, see appendix 1 & 2.

Q: How many new tyres can I order for each round?

A: See table in appendix 1, showing the **maximum** number of **new** tyres that can be ordered at each round

Q: How many tyres do I need for double header rounds?

A: Double headers are treated as two separate rounds.

Q: What is the latest date I can order my tyres?

A: The latest you can order tyres is midday ten days before the event. Any late entries may incur a surcharge.

Q: Do I have to purchase new wet tyres for every event?

A: No, as per the regulations, only at their first round will drivers be required to purchase at least one new wet set. After your first round Wet tyres, new or used, throughout the championship can be sealed and used again with no charge for sealing.

Q: Do I have to purchase new practice tyres?

A: No, you can register in used tyres instead of the maximum new tyres as in appendix 1 & 2

Q: Can I buy tyres at the event?

A: No, all tyres must be pre purchased 10 days before the event as per the regulations.

Q: Can I carry my wet tyres over?

A: Yes, you will be able to carry new & used wets over to the next meeting. At the end of the competitors racing, present your registered tyres, with an official championship tyre bag (tyre bags purchased in 2019 are also acceptable for sealing the tyres) to one of the tyre distribution team who will check and seal them and register them for future use.

At the following round you will need to re-register these into the meeting if you wish to use them.

Q: Can I order new wet tyres if i have sealed my wets from the previous round?

A: Yes, you can order new wets online, and register them into the meeting removing your equivalent sealed tyres.

Q: Do I need to use an “Official” British Kart Championship bag?

A: Yes, you can purchase tyre bags on line at <https://kartinguk.alphatiming.co.uk/register/series> that will be available at tyre collection when you collect tyres. We will carry a small limited stock.

Q: When do I need to register my tyres into the event?

A: Competitors must register all tyres, practice, slicks new or used, and all race tyres at the tyre distribution point into the event before their first practice session.

Q: when do i have to use my registered practice slicks?

A: For practice sessions 1 & 2, tyre choice is free. From practice session 3 and warm up, registered practice tyres only.

Q: What wets can I use in practice?

A: During practice, wet tyre choice is free, the use of race wets in practice or warm up is forbidden.

Q: Will there be checking of practice and race tyres?

A: Yes, tyres will be checked, this may be before, during or after practice sessions or races to ensure the correct usage of tyres for that particular class. It is the drivers' responsibility to ensure the correct tyres are fitted.

Q: Where will I be able to collect my tyres from?

A: Tyres can be collected as per the event timetable from the tyre distribution point where social distancing should be respected.

Q: What times are the tyre distribution open to collect tyres?

A: The tyre distribution point will be open on Thursday from 15.00 and Friday from 08.00

Q: What happens if my bar code comes off or cannot be read?

A: It is the drivers' responsibility to ensure that one of the two bar codes on each tyre is readable before leaving parc ferme.

Q: Will there be additional checks to tyres other than bar code scanning?

A: Yes, there will be additional testing and analysis of tyres at the scrutineers/organisers discretion.

Q: Who can collect the competitors tyres?

A: the competitor or mechanic or parent or guardian with the invoice number from their online tyre purchase.
